Albany Dining Lodge

The Albany Dining Lodge is the main building at Hebron Center. It has a seating capacity of 140. Tables and chairs for 140 are available. There is a complete commercial kitchen, including a 10 burner gas stove, walk-in cooler, 2 upright freezers, microwave oven, outdoor grill, ice maker, dishwasher, pots & pans, dishes, cups, & silverware. There are two bathrooms in the building (non-handicap accessible). A TV/VCR/DVD unit and an electronic keyboard are available. A wrap-around deck allows for outdoor meeting space in good weather.

Lamar Lodge (opened Spring 2006)

Lamar Lodge, located next to Albany Dining Lodge, is the newest addition to Hebron Center. This modern facility provides comfortable accommodations for 28 persons. The building is completely accessible, including parking. There are 7 bedrooms with 2 bunk beds in each (3 single beds and 1 double). Personal storage space is also provided. There are four bathrooms (sink, toilet, shower), two of which are fully handicapped accessible. Each bathroom serves two bedrooms. Lamar Lodge has a large meeting room and a kitchen/dining area to accommodate guests. The kitchen has a stove, refrigerator, microwave oven, dishes, and pots & pans. The Lodge is heated for year-round use. The main room has a gas fire place which adds warmth and welcome. Linen service available for an additional cost.

Maple Lodge

Maple Lodge is located just a short distance downhill from the Albany Dining Lodge. This Lodge can accommodate up to 24 persons. There are four bedrooms furnished with 3 bunk beds each. There are two bathrooms (sinks, toilet, and shower). The Lodge has a meeting area complete with a wood burning fire place and a complete kitchen (stove, refrigerator, microwave oven, dishes, pots & pans). A TV/VCR unit is available.

Bush Lodge

Bush Lodge is located just a short distance uphill from the Albany Dining Lodge. This Lodge can accommodate up to 20 persons. There are two bedrooms downstairs furnished with 3 bunk beds each. One bathroom (sink, toilet, shower/tub) serves these bedrooms. There is a larger bedroom upstairs furnished with 4 bunk beds (one bed has a double bed on bottom and a single bed on top). This bedroom has an attached bathroom (sink, toilet, shower). The Lodge has a meeting area complete with a wood burning fire place and a small complete kitchen (stove, refrigerator, microwave oven, dishes, pots & pans).

Fire Circle

Located above Bush Lodge is our Fire Circle. Benches accommodating some 50 people encircle a central fire pit. Wood is available. This area is ideal for outdoor worship, campfire stories, and group singing. Guitar player not included.

Field of Screams

The Field of Screams, located near Maple Lodge, is a large, flat playing field which will accommodate almost any size group for softball, soccer, and other field games. Equipment (playground balls, bats & balls, etc.) is available.

Hebron Center has a great sledding hill just outside the Lamar Lodge for winter fun in the snow. Bring your own sleds, toboggans, tubes, etc.

Carolyn Towers Outdoor Education Center

The Carolyn Towers Outdoor Education Center is located on Strawberry Hill, just above Lamar Lodge. Two platform tents will sleep six people each during the Spring, Summer, and Fall. A fire circle allows for outdoor cooking and campfire activities. A small building provides running water, bathrooms (sinks, toilets), and a meeting room.

Hiking Trails

Hebron Center has several miles of hiking trails which run throughout 450 acres. Maps are available.

Challenge Course

The Challenge Course (“low ropes” course) is located in the woods some distance from the lodges. The Course includes 10 elements which will challenge groups to work together and grow together. The Course is available in the Fall and late Spring. A trained facilitator is required. For more information, contact the Hebron Center Director at 854-3338.

Swimming Pool & Picnic Area

The Swimming Pool & Picnic Area has limited availability. The Pool Area is open June—August and is available to groups on Saturdays only (more availability during the first two weeks of June and last two weeks of August). Groups using the Pool Area must provide a certified lifeguard for every 25 participants.

General Information

It is strongly recommended that all groups bring a person certified in first aid and their own first aid kit. A first aid office is available, but not staffed.

A group at the East Hebron United Presbyterian Church is available to provide meal service for an additional fee.

All groups are asked to clean up after using the facility; cleaning supplies are provided. A dumpster is available for garbage disposal. Clean up helps keep our costs down.
