

THE TASK OF A MEMBER OF THE
PASTOR NOMINATING COMMITTEE (PNC)
(This is for duplication in the church bulletin or newsletter.)

- This position in the church is to receive top priority.
- If necessary, persons may resign from other responsibilities to adequately fulfill the tasks of this committee.
- Persons must be members on the active role of the church and have given consent to serve before nomination is acceptable.

The main task is:

1. To complete a Church Information Form.

And following the completion of this:

2. To search for a new pastor.

The primary responsibilities are to:

- Meet weekly to review the Personal Information Forms of available persons and discuss possible candidates.
- Be available to use some Sundays for listening to persons in other churches.
- Be available to interview persons on Sunday or during the week as the occasion requires.

The PNC is also responsible for ensuring that a financial review is done upon departure of the former pastor.
