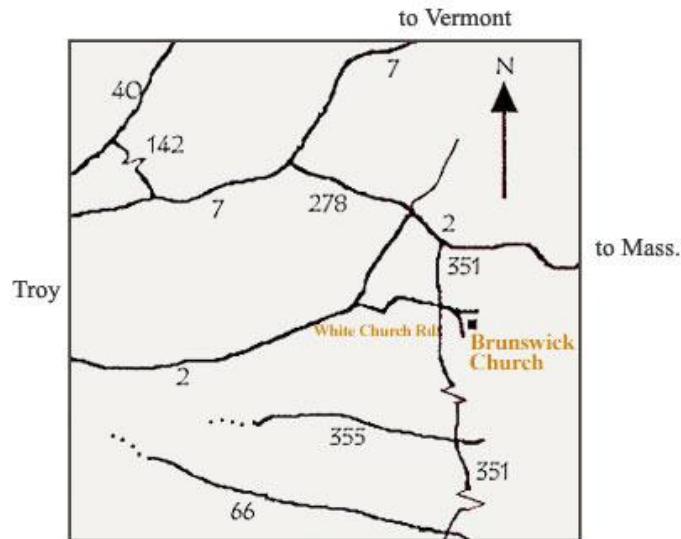

### NOTICE OF THIS MEETING IS BEING SENT TO YOU PER ALBANY PRESBYTERY STANDING RULES:

In accordance with Standing Rule I-3, notice of the Albany Presbytery Stated Meeting on January 29, 2011, is hereby given.

The proposed docket for the meeting along with relevant documents and reports will be posted/sent no later than Monday, January 24, 2011.

In preparation for discussion, debate, and vote on Proposed Amendment 10-1 which would create a new Form of Government for the PC(USA), please reference the information that was posted/sent earlier. It is important for each commissioner to study the material and come to the meeting on January 29 prepared to debate and vote on the proposed amendment. The Albany Presbytery Council has acted to recommend adoption of the new Form of Government. Council's rationale for this recommendation will be included in the documents to be posted/sent no later than Monday.

Other major items of business for the meeting will include one examination for ordination, two examinations for transfer of membership, and a recommendation from COM concerning waiver of per capita payments for one church. Relevant biographical information and statements of faith for those to be examined will be posted/sent no later than Monday. Worship will be led by members of the Pakistani-American Fellowship.
